8. MEDIATION EXPERIENCE

Acting as Mediator in each of the following cases:-

- A large scale construction dispute relating to the conversion of a City Centre Hotel into 63 residential apartments. Nationally known companies on either side (Employer and Main Contractor). Claim value £2.1m. Issues involved delay, negligent design and remediation costs.
- Construction dispute relating to a high value private residential home. Claim by builder £37,000 and counterclaim for remedial works by the house owner £23,000.
- Dispute between an international petroleum company and the operators of three petrol stations in the North East of England, all supplied under a solus agreement. The petrol company claimed £280,000, the operators counterclaimed a similar amount. The case was part of a class action in which generic issues of principle had been tried and judgment give.
- Small scale dispute between a national motor insurer and website design company (claim £5,600 and counterclaim £5,600). Allegations of breach of contract on each side. Complicated IT issues involved despite the low monetary values.
- Dispute over an insurance claim in respect of high value pieces of jewellery.
- Dispute between Vets concerning the exclusion of one Vet from the business and the division of assets.
- Dispute between insurance company and a private individual in relation to a Range Rover.
- Dispute between householders and a regional builder concerning plot boundaries for a new house.
- Dispute between private individuals concerning a series of alleged loans.
