2. Mediation and Alternative Dispute Resolution Experience:

Experiences of mediation cases, include:

- Resolving dispute over fitness for purpose and delivery between UK local authority and US NASDAQ listed software company;
- Concluding agreement in mediation between UK website development agency and national holiday sites operator over ownership of intellectual property and other website assets;
- Resolving issue between shareholders of technology company as to valuation and the basis for exit of shareholder, whilst maintaining viability of remaining business;
- Dealing with dilapidations and lease clause dispute including the extent of a demised leasehold property;
- Inheritance dispute between children of deceased as to appropriate shares and specific assets;
- Nuisance Dispute involving alleged damage to property from works in neighbouring property;
- Dispute between lender to development company in relation to significant residential development site, and the borrower who was seeking to avoid repossession;
- Mediating "Shareholder" dispute between financial advisers in failed merger, involving financial, IP ownership and reputational issues.
- Mediation over fitness of high-end motor vehicle

- Shareholder dispute involving two equal shareholders in a £2m engineering company, with one party looking to exit and widely differing expectations on value.
- Mediating dispute between supplier and business customer in construction supplies, formerly associated companies, with allegations of overcharging, interruption of supplies and unilateral changes to terms – value approximately £500k.

Other dispute experience: As managing director and founder of a law firm, Paul not only worked closely in continuous matters with his litigation colleagues but also close to the activity of those colleagues in managing the entire firm. He also dealt with any potential issues arising both between his company and other entities, and in resolving any issues within the business.
